SYNOPSIS

Philipp has disturbing dreams whenever people sleep on other floors directly below him. He lands into a weird world of endless ropes with these same people hanging onto them, trying to kick him off. With the help of his friend Alex, he tries to escape his nightmares. The two buddies are already struggling in real life, from being jobless it spiralled down to sleeping rough on London streets. To fend off the cold, they developed their own technique by squatting empty flats *à la gentleman style*. They pretend to be looking for an apartment, leaving a window discreetly opened during viewings for later possession. While Philipp struggles with his nightmares, Alex tries hard to get things going. Philipp, clearly exhausted, dozes off in a double decker. The nightmares start again with people kicking him off the rope. But this time, he gets a salvational hand from a woman who also fell asleep just below him on the bus. Philipp becomes obsessed with the girl and runs after her, following her into a hotel. He feels the urge to see her again in his dreams as she could be the answer to end his nightmares. Alex reluctantly agrees to the latest lunacy of his friend and both end up on the rooftop of the hotel, trying to find the exact spot of the woman's room. Philipp sends Alex running up and down the floors, waking up all hotel guests disturbing philipp's dream. Finally Philipp manages to be reunited but has to pay the ultimate price, his own life.



MARCUS WOSCHNAGG

Writer, Director

Born in Cairo, Egypt. Marcus Woschnagg grew up in Kenya and Austria where he studied Architecture at the Vienna University of Technology in Austria.

He completed a doctorate in Urbanism *Parameters for a 3 Dimensional City* and gained professional work experience in Architecture in the US, France, Belgium, Australia, the UK and Austria. From 2010 onwards he attended evening courses at the film school Raindance in London. For the past 10 years Woschnagg worked as an Architect with a focus on urban and cultural projects stretching from London to Abu Dhabi. During the past two years he wrote and directed his first short film *Fever of the Urbanist* in London. He is now working on his next short in Vienna, currently in pre-production stage.

WALTER WERZOWA

Music

Walter Werzowa grew up in Vienna, Austria, studying classical guitar and music.

As an adult he collaborated with his mentor Otto M. Zykan on numerous orchestral pieces. But it was Walter's pop hit remix *Bring Me Edelweiss* that topped the charts worldwide and brought musical recognition. Following his completion of University of Southern California's post-graduate programme for Film and Television Scoring, Werzowa founded *Musikvergnuegen*. His music production company has created original trailer scores for Disney, Warner Brothers and 20th Century Fox; commercials and promos for Coca Cola, Verizon, Kia and corporate audio branding. His audio masterbrand *mnemonic* for Intel has become the most performed melody in the history of broadcast.

Werzowa has developed his business from a one-man operation to an award winning (Telly, Clio and Emmy) state-of-the-art boutique sound house located in the heart of Hollywood. High profile collaborators have included Stephen Spielberg, Wim Wenders and Red Bull.

Born in Warsaw, Poland. Maja Zamojda moved to London in 2004 where she graduated from London College of Communication with a BA in Film and Video studies.

In January 2011 she completed an MA Cinematography course at the National Film and Television School.
